- Ray Eickmeyer shared his presentation on the 2015 Environment of Care report as required by the Department of Health.

Patient and Family Advisory Council – Carol Velasquez, CNO

Carol shared her presentation on the Patient & Family Advisory Council concept. The Patient & Family Advisory Council provides a mechanism to demonstrate our commitment to patient and family centered care which aligns with LCCH's values – relationships, integrity, compassion, and respect.

Home Health – Kevin Abel, CEO

STATE OF THE HOSPITAL REPORTS

Operating Report – Brad Hankins, COO

- The DEXA machine for bone density scanning will move February 25th from the clinic to the hospital. The clinic space will be used for the orthopedic clinic.
- LCC productivity in January resulted in 1870 RVU's, the second highest number of encounters.
- The PT/OT makeover continues with completion anticipated at the end of next week.
- Dr. Kevin Morris, DPM, continues adding patients to his clinic.
- Looking at moving Dr. Witt to the clinic 1-2 days per week.

Quality Report & Patient Care Services - Carol Velasquez, CNO

- Quality and Patient Safety In January, there were three medication errors, with no adverse effects. The Emergency Department had four returns within 48 hours. There were nine non-billing related concerns. Four of the nine patient or family concerns have been resolved to the patient's or family member's satisfaction.
- Patient Care Services The Lab is adding Hemoglobin A1C to our testing menu, which will provide more timely results for hospital and clinic patients.

- January financial statements closed with net income at (\$58,333) for the month. The primary concern was deductions from revenue.
