SPECIAL REPORTS:

Replacement Hospital Review – Kevin Abel

- It has been determined that the hospital will be asking the voters for a bond in the amount of \$19,000,000 for the replacement hospital. Reports indicate, based on current interest rates, the tax assessment on a home valued at \$300,000 would increase \$9.33 per month.
- Chelan Valley Citizens for a New Hospital is active and has worked with various community members regarding the upcoming election.
- The bond resolution prepared by Foster Pepper and reviewed by the Board at the last meeting was approved. The election date is November 4, 2014.

Compliance Presentation – Lee Tinsley

LCCH Compliance Program - Lee Tinsley, Compliance Officer presented a Compliance and Utilization Review program update. All contracts are reviewed each year to insure the payer or commissioned entity is not on the OIG excluded list. RAC audits are used to detect and prevent fraud and/or abuse of the system. Utilization management provides high quality care at a reasonable cost to payers, and is required by Medicare. Medical records are reviewed to determine the severity of illness, intensity of services and discharge screens.

Organizational Chart – Kevin Abel, CEO

The organizational structure with changes related to the Lake Chelan Clinic merger was reviewed.
 The primary adjustments were moving Brad Hankins into the Clinic Administrator roll since
 Barbara Berg is retiring. Food Services will report to Ken Peters and Ken will report to the CEO rather than the COO. The new organizational chart was approved by a motion of the Board.

STATE OF THE HOSPITAL REPORTS

Quality Report & Patient Care Services – Carol Velasquez-CNO

- For May, there were no falls reported. There were no episodes of restraint used during May.
 There was one medication error on Sanctuary reported. The medication administration areas on both Sanctuary and MSU have identified as "Do Not Disturb" zones, to decrease the risk of distraction and interruptions during medication administration.
- Maria Rubalcava from Environmental Services has accepted a position in the Sanctuary, to start later this month, after earning her CNA.
- Kim Freel, our ultrasound and echocardiogram tech, has accepted a management position at a
 physician's clinic. Wanda Nutley will be attending specific training on echocardiography so that
 we can continue to perform echocardiograms here.

Operating Report –Brad Hankins, COO

- The new compressor is installed in our second HVAC unit and should be operational by the end of this week.
- The tentative date to bring the new two story modular on sight is August 4th. The business office staff will begin vacating the existing modular this week, and the building is scheduled to be moved the week of July 29th. Occupancy of the new building is scheduled for the last week of August.
- Environmental services are fully staffed for the first time in several months.

Chief Financial Officer - Robert Wiegenstein, CFO

- May closed with a positive income of \$255,654 for the month.
