- Port of Chelan County Economic Study - Aimee Pope Port of Chelan County, Kevin Abel

The Port of Chelan County will be reviewing the Lake Chelan Valley Healthcare Industry Assessment study conducted by Berger ABAM on the 19th. The study emphasizes the positive economic impact the hospital has on the community.

- Tele-Neurology Program - Carol Velasquez, CNO

The Foundation and Guild Y voted to support more than \$13,000 for equipment for use with teleneurology. The tele-neurology program would use the same electronic communication methods that we use with tele-stroke and utilize neurologists from the Swedish Health System. The program would be mutually beneficial, we would maximize the return on our investments, and this would keep patients in the community for health care.

STATE OF THE HOSPITAL REPORTS

Operating Report –Brad Hankins, COO

- With the merge of Lake Chelan Clinic we are finding that the staff is dedicated, engaging and adapting well to change.
- We have been able to do an assessment of materials, equipment, staff, & training needs, and are looking forward to working in areas of patient scheduling, practice management and clinic structure in the future.

Quality Report & Patient Care Services – Carol Velasquez-CNO

- The transfusion review, revealed the C:T ratio was 1:1 in August, with both units transfused meeting criteria.
- The second quarter surgical case review was completed and all cases had matching pre-op and post-op diagnoses, and in cases where Pathology was sent, the findings supported the diagnoses.
- OB staffing has become a challenge, with two RN's taking full-time positions at CWH. We're
 evaluating various options to provide coverage until we can hire a permanent nurse or at least a
 traveler to bridge the gap.
- Kudos to Vernita Nolan for earning her BSN earlier this month.

Chief Financial Officer – Vickie Bodle, CFO

- August closed with net income at \$49,128 for the month. Year to date net income is \$361,453.
- AR days 62.2.

Chief Executive Officer – Kevin Abel, CEO

- Regional Support Network The Regional Support Network Board (RSN) was asked by the state of Washington to merge with either the Greater Columbia (Yakima, Tri-Cities) region or the Spokane region for the provision of mental health services. They elected to merge with the Greater Columbia region and were rejected by that entity. The state and the RSN are now entering discussions regarding whether to merge with Spokane or if Chelan, Douglas, Grant and Okanogan counties should create their own RSN. There will be significant impacts on the region as it ties in with the proposed \$92.5 million state innovation grant that will drive the coordination of behavioral health and primary care services. Confluence Health is pulling the representatives from Chelan/Douglas to discuss the possible merging and conversions.
- WSHA Quality Reporting In October the Washington State Hospital Association will go live with the new hospital quality reporting system that ranks hospital performance with several quality indicators. The system is designed with the public in mind and will give basic quality outcome measures for use in deciding which hospital to use.
- Lake Chelan Recreation Development Foundation Two members of the Lake Chelan Recreation Development Foundation requested that LCCH support their efforts with the PUD for an aquatic center to be funded and constructed in the Lake Chelan area. I wrote the letter in support for PUD funding as the board has approved letters in 2008 and 2013.
- Board Retreat Date We decided the date for the Board Retreat. It will be November 18th at Lakeside Lodge.

 Mobile Unit – Pacific Mobile removed the single story unit and the foundation and placing of the new mobile unit are on schedule.
