




Please adhere to the following guidelines to help keep our patients, staff, and visitors **SAFE**

Nonadherence to any of the infection-prevention principles outlined here, will result in denial of visitation

<p>Screening</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Includes patients, healthcare personnel, and visitor Symptoms of COVID-19? Exposure to others with suspected or confirmed SARS-CoV-2 infection? 	<p>Source Control</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Visitor must wear appropriate Source Control upon arrival to and throughout their stay in the facility Should be well-fitting (e.g., facemask) and cover the nose and mouth Mandatory at <u>ALL TIMES</u>*  <p>*See Proclamation 20-25.14</p>	<p>Physical Distancing</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Mandatory at <u>ALL TIMES</u> per state requirements. Visitors will follow physical distancing of at least 6 feet from others (including patients). 	<p>Clean Hands</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Use alcohol-based hand-rub before and after contact with patients and surroundings and before/after any contact with their cloth mask, facemask, or respirator 
<p>No EATING or DRINKING in Patient Rooms</p>	<p>Restrictions</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Visitors will not be present during <u>aerosol generating</u> and <u>other procedures</u> See list of aerosol generating procedures 	<p>Limited Access</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Visitors should only visit the patient's room. They should not go to other locations in the facility. Exception granted for the use of the nearest public restroom. Visitors should not use patient restrooms. 	<p>Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Staff will provide guidance to visitors regarding the appropriate use of PPE (when applicable)
