

Please adhere to the following guidelines to help keep our patients, staff, and visitors **SAFE**Nonadherence to any of the infection-prevention principles outlined here, will results in denial of visitation

Screening

- Includes patients, healthcare personnel, and visitor
- Symptoms of COVID-19?
- Exposure to others with suspected or confirmed SARS-CoV-2 infection?

Source Control

- Visitor must wear appropriate Source Control upon arrival to and throughout their stay in the facility
- Should be well-fitting (e.g., facemask) and cover the nose and mouth
- Mandatory at <u>ALL TIMES</u>*

Physical Distancing

- Mandatory at <u>ALL TIMES</u> per state requirements.
- Visitors will follow physical distancing of at least 6 feet from others (including patients).



Clean Hands

Use alcohol-based handrub before and after contact with patients and surroundings and before/after any contact with their cloth mask, facemask, or respirator



No EATING or DRINKING in Patient Rooms

Restrictions

- Visitors will not be present during <u>aerosol generating</u> and <u>other procedures</u>
- See list of aerosol generating procedures

Limited Access

- Visitors should only visit the patient's room.
- They should not go to other locations in the facility.
- Exception granted for the use of the nearest public restroom.
- Visitors should not use patient restrooms.

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

 Staff will provide guidance to visitors regarding the appropriate use of PPE (when applicable)
